

May Graduation Deadlines

Graduation – Key Deadlines & Actions

Graduation Date: 28 May 2026 –

Remaining exams: Can be taken in the extraordinary session by 28 April to be eligible for May graduation

Online application: 27 March – 8 May (apply by 7 May)

In-person documents: Submit to Student Secretariat from 27 March – 8 May

Important: Check at least 1 month before applying that all exams are registered in Delphi

Follow all deadlines carefully to avoid graduation delays

By Friday, 8 May, 2026

Submission of the graduation application must be completed through your **personal Delphi platform**.

Once completed online, you must also submit the following documents **in person** to the **Student Secretariat** from the 27 of March - 8 of May:

1. Signed graduation application form
2. University Green Book (if available)
3. Payment receipt
4. Thesis assignment form, signed by both the supervisor and the student

*(Note: You can download this form during the online application process. In case of discrepancy between the thesis title on the application and the assignment form, the **assignment form title will prevail.**)*

By Monday, 4 May, 2026

The following documents must be submitted to the **Didactic Secretariat (Mrs. Magdalena Acuna)**:

1. White booklet of optional courses/**seminars must have the exam dates and proven certificate of participation** (completed with all CFUs)
2. Internship completion certificate (if not previously submitted)

By Wednesday, 20 May, 2026

Upload their final thesis/dissertation to their Delphi platform no later than 8 days before the graduation date.

Important Notes for AA4 Students Only:

- The PPV (Prova Pratica Valutativa) is scheduled for **to be defined you can take it in March 11 check April graduation deadlines**
- The **linguistic knowledge certificate** if not yet provided must be submitted by **30 April 2026** at the latest.

Withdrawing from Graduation

If you decide to cancel your graduation for this session:

- You must **cancel your application directly on Delphi**, and
- Immediately notify the **Student Secretariat** via email:
